

Important information for admission into various Undergraduate and Post-graduate Degree Programmes of AAU for the year 2022-23

A. Important Dates

The following is the schedule of admission for the academic year 2022-23

1. Issue of Notification for Common Entrance Test for UG Programme (CETUG) : July 01, 2022 (Friday)
2. Issue of online application forms for all courses : July 01, 2022 (Friday)
3. Last date for online application for all courses : July 25, 2022 (Monday)
4. Date of Common Entrance Test to be conducted at various centres of Assam will be notified separately.
5. Declaration of CETUG result : August 15, 2022 (Monday)
6. Date of First counseling for all eligible candidates for UG Programme : August 24-27, 2022 (Wednesday-Saturday)
Venue : Dr. M. C. Das Memorial Auditorium, Assam Agricultural University, Jorhat
Time : 9.00 A.M. onwards
7. Date of reporting at respective College/Hostel : August 31, 2022 (Wednesday)
8. Date of orientation/starting classes : September 01, 2022 (Thursday)
9. Date of Second counseling for all eligible candidates subject to availability of vacant seats at AAU Headquarters : September 07, 2022 (Wednesday)
10. Admission to all PG programmes this year will be undertaken on the basis of the NTA score secured by the prospective candidate in the examination conducted by the ICAR, except for the Ph.D. programme in Tea Husbandry & Technology. For entry into the Department of Tea Husbandry & Technology, entrance test would be conducted by the concerned Department on the date to be notified in due course.

B. Instruction for the Candidates:

- 1) The candidates are required to submit the application online. Request for change of data and other information in the submitted application will not be entertained in any case.
- 2) No separate call letters will be issued to the candidates for appearing in the counseling. The list of candidates in order of merit will be uploaded in the University website, www.aau.ac.in in due course.
- 3) **The candidate shall have to submit the payment slips(s) and self-attested copies of all relevant testimonials at the time of counseling, failure of which will result in cancellation of his/her candidature. The candidate must produce the testimonials in original during counseling.**
- 4) Candidates, if selected, shall have to take admission immediately after the counseling on payment of necessary fees as given in the Information Bulletin. A candidate failing to take admission on the day shall forfeit the seat.
- 5) Failure to report to the Selection Committee in person as per time schedule shall have no claim for the seat.
- 6) Appearing in the counseling does not guarantee right to admission in any programme. Selection Committee reserves the right to accept or reject a candidate under the rules in force.
- 7) In case the seats are exhausted before all the candidates appear for counseling, the University will not be responsible for non-availability of seats.
